Rules of visitation

- 1. All inmates in the jail may only have one visit per day
- 2. There are no cell phones, drinks or food in the visiting booth. The inmate will not bring any drinks or food to the visiting booth.
- 3. There will be no female and male inmates in the visiting booth at the same time.
- 4. No more than two people may visit at the same time.
- 5. Children of inmates under the age of 13 are allowed to visit their immediate family (mother, father, sibling, grandmother, grandfather, stepmother, or stepfather) provided they are with an adult. Children 13 years of age or older may visit their parent/step parent without adult supervision. All other visitors must be at least 18 years old.
- 6. Visitors may be required to show I.D.
- 7. Inmates in the Richland County Jail from Wisconsin prison system on an order to produce are prohibited from having visits, unless approved by the warden according to Wisconsin statues.
- 8. There may be a search of visitors and their possessions
- 9. Inmates may be searched before and after a visit
- 10. Visiting hours are Saturdays and Sundays 9:00 am to 11:00 am and 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm and Wednesdays 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm. The visits may be limited to 15 minutes. For inmates that are classified as an 8 they are allowed a visit between the hours of 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm Sunday evenings, if they have not received a visit for that day. These visits will be allowed 30 minutes.
