

**RICHLAND COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AND JUDICIARY COMMITTEE
MEETING
Friday, November 10, 2017**

The Richland County Board of Supervisors Law Enforcement and Judiciary Committee met on Friday, November 10, 2017 at 8:30am in the County Board Room of the Richland County Court House in Richland Center, Wisconsin.

Committee members present at the meeting were: Committee Chair Fred Clary and Committee members Buford Marshall, Gary Peters, Don Seep and Marty Brewer. Present from the Richland County Sheriff's Department were Sheriff Jim Bindl, Chief Deputy Chad Kanable, and Amber Muckler. Also present for the meeting or a portion of the meeting was Richland County Clerk of Circuit Court Stacy Kleist, DA Jennifer Harper and Dispatcher Jacob Rupnow.

Agenda Item #1: Call to Order: Committee Chair Fred Clary called the meeting to order at 8:30am.

Agenda Item #2: Read and Approve Notice of Posting for November 10, 2017 LEJC Meeting: Committee chair Clary confirmed with Sheriff Bindl that the meeting was properly posted with one amendment. Upon receiving confirmation Clary declared meeting properly posted.

Agenda Item #3: Read and Approve the Agenda for November 10, 2017 Meeting: Motioned by Marty Brewer to approve the agenda. 2nd to this motion by Gary Peters. Motion passed.

Agenda Item #4: Read and Approve Minutes of the October 13, 2017 LEJC Meeting: Motion by Gary Peters to approve the minutes as printed. 2nd to this motion by Buford Marshall. Motion passed, minutes accepted.

Agenda Item #5: Coroner Updates: Not available for this meeting.

Agenda Item #6: Probate Update: Not available for this meeting.

Agenda Item #7: Clerk of Court Updates: Clerk of Court Kleist went over her reports with the committee members. She discussed revenue that was received from the state for interpreter fees state aid. She discussed some things that will be happening with the SDC (State Debt Collection) and how it will affect her department's collections.

Agenda Item #8: District Attorney Updates: DA Harper went over her overall budget with the committee members, she did not have a report available for the month.

Agenda Item #9: Approve monthly invoices and other Sheriff's Department reports: The committee went over the invoices submitted for the month. Motion to approve the invoices for payment made by Marty Brewer, second to this

motion by Gary Peters. Motion approved. Sheriff Bindl went over the blue sheet jail statistics with the committee members and staffing issues on the road and jail.

Agenda Item #10: Approval of proposed amendment to Ordinance 89-7:

Chief Deputy Kanable handed out draft language on the amendment to Ordinance 89-7 and went over this draft language with the committee members. There are a few small corrections that need to be made to the wording and brought back for the December 8th LEJC agenda and then move forward to the County Board for approval.

Agenda Item #15: Mapping, Radio System & Squad Updates: Mapping – no changes for the month, EMS will be the only changes that will be happening to affect mapping issues. Currently Buena Vista township is the only township ready to make the change. Radio – there was a complete radio/dispatch failure this past week, within a half hour Motorola was out and had the system back up. It's thought that it was a power issue. Squads – The new squad is here and ready to go except for a computer for the squad.

- a.) Chief Deputy Kanable informed the committee that the Lieutenant's squad needs a computer since he is covering many complaints. Kanable stated that the department does not have final numbers, he states he thinks it could cost around \$4600 for the computer and installation equipment. This cost can be taken out of the new equipment and computer maintenance line items. Motion to approve this purchase by Don Seep, second to this motion by Marty Brewer. More discussion on funding for this item. Motion approved.

Agenda Item #16: Adjourn; Motion by Don Seep to adjourn until the regular LEJC meeting on Friday, December 8, 2017 at 8:30am. Second to this motion by Marty Brewer. Motion passed, meeting adjourned.
