

**RICHLAND COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AND JUDICIARY COMMITTEE
MEETING
Friday, December 13, 2019**

The Richland County Board of Supervisors Law Enforcement and Judiciary Committee met on Friday, December 13, 2019 at 9:00am in the County Board Room of the Richland County Court House in Richland Center, Wisconsin.

Committee members present at the meeting were: Committee Chair Marty Brewer and Committee members Buford Marshall, Kerry Severson, Larry Sebranek and Melissa Luck. Present from the Richland County Sheriff's Department were Sheriff Jim Bindl, Chief Deputy Chad Kanable, and Amber Muckler. Also present for the meeting or a portion of the meeting was Richland County Clerk of Circuit Court Stacy Kleist, DA Jennifer Harper, Denise Klingaman, and Jenifer Laue.

Agenda Item #1: Call to Order: Committee Chair Brewer called the meeting to order at 8:30am.

Agenda Item #2: Read and Approve Notice of Posting for December 13, 2019 LEJC Meeting: Committee Chair Brewer confirmed with Sheriff Bindl that the meeting was properly posted. Upon receiving confirmation Brewer declared meeting properly posted.

Agenda Item #3: Read and Approve the Agenda for December 13, 2019 Meeting: Motioned by Melissa Luck to approve the agenda. 2nd to this motion by Buford Marshall. Motion passed.

Agenda Item #4: Read and Approve Minutes of the November 8, 2019 LEJC Meeting: Motion by Melissa Luck to approve the minutes as printed. 2nd to this motion by Larry Sebranek. Motion passed, minutes accepted.

Agenda Item #5: Coroner Updates: 5 cases autopsy cases pending, could take up to 4 to 6 months to get results. The coroner sent other yearly statistics for 2019.

Agenda Item #6: Clerk of Court Update: Clerk of Court Kleist went over her reports with the committee members. There was discussion regarding issues with the video conferencing system, there is money in the 2020 budget to help resolve this issue.

Agenda Item #7: Probate Updates: Jenifer Laue went over her reports with the committee members. Laue went over her expenses for the month with the committee members and briefly discussed the events going on in court towards the end of 2019.

Agenda Item #8: District Attorney Updates: DA Harper discussed events going on in her department for the month and current cases going through the court system. There was a brief discussion on the horse rescue that happened in the county in November and also on a new reporting system that the DA and Sheriff's Department have been in communication with each other, this is required statistical reporting for the FBI.

Agenda Item #9: Approve monthly invoices and other Sheriff's

Department reports: Sheriff Bindl went over the invoices for the month with the committee members. Motion to approve paying the invoices made by Buford Marshall, second to this motion by Larry Sebranek. Motion approved.

Sheriff Bindl went over the jail statistic report with the committee members and discussed inmates that are currently in the jail that are very disruptive and uncooperative.

Agenda Item #10: Approve hotel rate over the state rate: Amber Muckler informed the committee members that a deputy went to training and required a hotel stay of 2 nights at the rate of \$89, which is over the state allowed rate of \$82. Motion to approve this rate made by Buford Marshall, second to this motion by Larry Sebranek. Motion approved.

Agenda Item #11: SCAAP Grant funds received: Chief Deputy Kanable informed the committee of funds we've received from the SCAAP Grant which was around \$1700, the department would like the funds put into the New Car Outlay. Motion to approve putting these grant funds into new car outlay made by Buford Marshall, second to this motion made by Melissa Luck. Motion approved.

Agenda Item #12: Mapping, Radio System & Squad Updates: Mapping – 2 issues in the village of Boaz, it is being taken care of in the next week. Melissa and Barb are currently applying for a grant for mapping and the new 911 system. Radio – work is going to begin on Tuesday at the Bunker Tower. Billing for this work may not happen until 2020, if that is the case the department may see if the 2019 funds can be used to do the same exact work at Sylvan. Discussion on putting a repeater that the department currently has on the roof of Ithaca Schools as currently there is no radio contact that can be made once deputies are inside the school. Squad – 2 squads are being repaired after accidents caused by deer. The second K-9 squad is up and running. The pickups are still being built and we are waiting on them.

Agenda Item #13: Adjourn; Motion by Melissa Luck to adjourn until the regular LEJC meeting on Friday, January 10, 2020 at 9:00am. Second to this motion by Buford Marshall. Motion passed, meeting adjourned.
